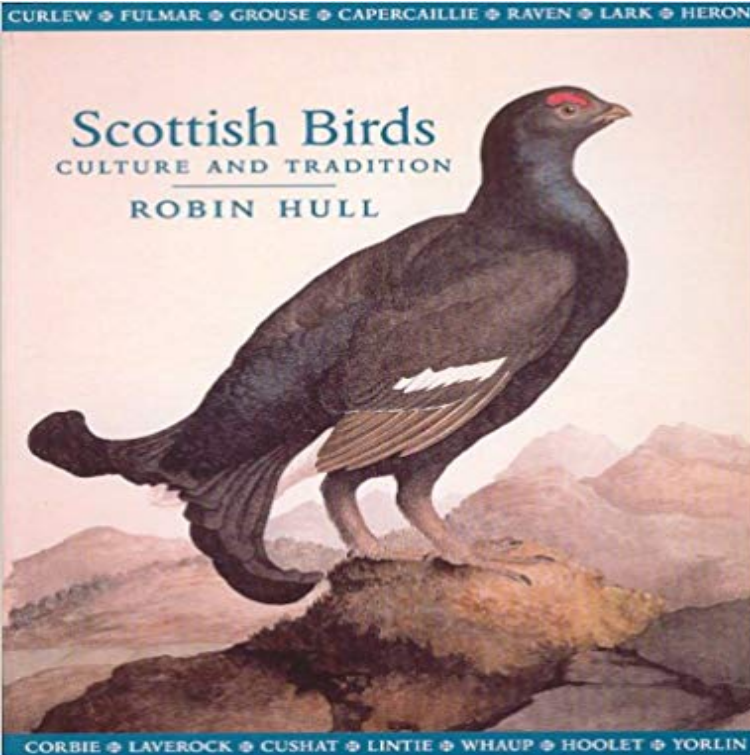


Scottish Birds: Culture and Tradition
